My World of Work

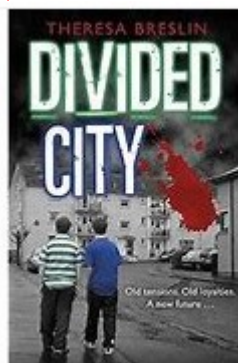

The activities will help us identify our own skills and learn about the world of work, the key sectors and what jobs Scotland need, or may need, in the future; sparking possible future career aspirations.

Body Systems

Linking with our Health and Wellbeing focus on 'Growing Up', we will also be investigating different systems within our body. As a class we are learning about the Reproductive System and learners will choose one of the other systems to explore e.g. Digestive System, Circulatory System.
