MATHS: This term we will tackle...

- vertical and horizontal lines of symmetry
- place value, at an appropriate level for each child
- time working on 24h clock notation and converting between 12 and 24hr, as well as converting minutes to hours and vice versa
- In Samson Maths we will initially be tackling mental addition

TOPIC: the upper school will be finding out about Natural Disasters. This will include researching the different disaster categories in order to create a model/poster/ Sway presentation to show their findings. Also included will be looking at the reasons behind natural disasters and identifying/ labelling more technical diagrams of the earth, volcanoes, tornadoes etc



READING FOCUS

Our class novel is First Aid for Fairies by Lari Don. The story is set in the South of Scotland and will involve finding out about fabled and mythical creatures. Through the novel we will work on making predictions, character studies and making inferences.
