OUR TERM 2 FOCUS

<u>Literacy</u>

P1—This term we will finish learning our single sounds and introduce formation of letters. We group the formation according to letters which are formed similarly. This is the formation grouping: I t i j; c o a d g q; r n m h b p k; u y; w v; e s f x z. We will begin to learn tricky words (words which cannot be sounded out) and will continue to blend 3 letter words (CVC consonant, vowel, consonant).

<u>Maths</u>

We will begin to learn about addition within 5. We will practise adding 0, 1 and small doubles mentally. We will also use concrete materials to extend and reinforce this knowledge. We will continue to revise working within 10 with a focus on numbers before, after and in-between.

<u>Topic</u>

We will be covering events, festivals and celebrations which take place during the beginning of November including Halloween, Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day and the season of Autumn.

Christmas: As part of our Christmas topic this year we will be learning about how Christmas is celebrated around the world. If you have connections to other countries that you would like to share with us, please let us know. Additionally, we will have a large focus on Expressive Arts as we work towards our Christmas Concert.
