Maths and Numeracy

In numeracy, we will be extending our knowledge of number through addition and subtraction. We will continue to work on our Mental Maths skills. In maths, Mrs Miller will focus on pattern and relationships.




Literacy

P3 will focus on beginning to write some persuasive texts and letters, we will make links to our topic and Christmas where possible. This term we will also be creating acrostic poems relating to events (e.g., bonfire night/Christmas) or words relating to our topic. We will continue to learn new spelling patterns using the Jolly Phonics programmer.

Topic

Our IDL topic this term is 'How Things Work'. We will explore how different objects can be affected by a variety of movement and force. We will also investigate the properties of materials. Towards the end of term 2, we will begin to focus on Christmas. We will touch upon Christmas in the past, comparing this to the present day. Additionally, we will have a large focus on Expressive Arts as we work towards our Christmas show.



READING FOCUS

This term, we will be reading a variety of seasonal books within the classroom. The children will also have the opportunity to engage with the novel 'The Christmasaurus' by Tom Fletcher.

P3 will also be involved in teacher led reading activities, comprehension tasks, and reading for enjoyment. When TOM FLETCHER reading in groups, we will continue to focus on our reciprocal reading skills such as predicting and summarising.
