Our Term 2 Focus

This term our main 'topic' focus is Space. The pupils are already excited to learn about the different planets within our solar system. We will think about the relative size and distance of the planets from the Sun. We will also be learning about the movement of the moon and why it appears to have different shapes as well as the movement of the Earth on it's axis and how that impacts on the seasons of the year. We will be adding in a technology focus finding out what it would be like to travel to Space and the different careers that are involved.



In Numeracy we are completing our focus on subtraction and will be moving onto multiplication. Any help learning those tables at home would be very much appreciated! We will be learning different strategies to help us with multiplying larger numbers mentally as well as using written methods correctly. In Maths with Miss McClymont the children are learning all about measure and are enjoying lots of practical activities to help deepen their understanding.

This term our written focus will begin with Poetry and trying out lots of different styles to describe events, nature and the Seasons. We will also be enjoying some short stories and will use these to inspire some short stories of our own!



In Health and Wellbeing the children will be learning about where our food comes from and will be taking part in visits and practical activities to explore that further. In PE pupils will be learning some Hockey skills and a spot of Badminton.
