Our Term 2 Focus

This term our main 'topic' focus is Space. The pupils are already excited to learn about the different planets within our solar system. We will think about the relative size and distance of the planets from the Sun. We will also be learning about the movement of the moon and why it appears to have different shapes as well as the movement of the Earth on it's axis and how that impacts on the seasons of the year. We will be adding in a technology focus finding out what it would be like to travel to Space and the different careers that are involved.



In Numeracy we are continuing our focus on mental multiplication. Any help learning those tables at home would be very much appreciated! We are also continuing to learn about the properties of 2D shapes, linking these with 3D shapes.



This term our written focus will begin with Poetry and learning about the different literary techniques we can use to make our writing interesting. So far we have written about Halloween, Bonfire Night and tried our hand at war poetry. We will soon move on to report writing.
