Our Term 3 Focus

This term our topic focus will be all about Vikings and how they impacted life in Scotland. We will find out how they arrived in the United Kingdom and how they lived here. We will be able to link this to lots of different areas of the curriculum.



The P5s will be taking part in The Scottish Opera project based on stories from the Viking era, we hope you will be able to come and join us for the presentation.

This term our Numeracy focus is multiplication and division, investigating the relationship between them. We will then explore fractions, decimals and percentages. In Mathematics the children will be learning all about Data Handling.

Our literacy focus to begin with is Scots Language, we will be learning our Scots poems (please help practise at home!) to perform in front of an audience. We will be learning the meaning of lots of Scots words and creating our own definitions wall. During this term we are also very lucky to work with Feis Ros, musicians who promote Scottish music, and the P4s will be able to share their learning with parents.

In writing we are finishing off our creative writing block by writing some more super stories. We will then move onto report writing and persuasive writing based on our topic or other school events.

Finally, in Health and Wellbeing the children will be learning about different ways to stay safe in our local area and who can help them. They will enjoy visits from Police and Paramedics and visit the Lifeboats.

This term our reading focus is Non-fiction. We will be learning lots of different skills needed to find information and use it to create our own writing.
