#### Our Term 4 Focus

#### Literacy -

In early level we will continue to focus on blending (running sounds together to read a word) and revise diagraphs and the formation of letters. We will also continue to explore the importance of capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and writing on the line. Capital letters are being introduced and children are learning to recognise them and match them to the lower case letter. We are exploring descriptive writing and using our descriptive bubbles, such as colour and shape, to describe people and places.

#### Numeracy and Mathematics-

In Numeracy, children will be focusing on adding and subtracting within 5, 10 and 20. Towards the end of term, we will explore multiplication and division. In Mathematics, children are exploring money. In early level, we will be working on identifying all coins up to £2 and paying for items costing up to at least 10p. We will also be working on data handling and measure with Mrs Miller on Friday.

#### Topic-

This term our focus will be on learning about how to keep ourselves fit and healthy. We will focus on recognising and naming the main food groups (The Eatwell Guide), follow healthy recipes and explore where food comes from. We will also look at our senses and how our bodies work.



#### READING FOCUS

We share stories every day. Children often vote to decide the class story and are encouraged to say why they like or dislike a book.

We are focusing on:

- Identifying the author, illustrator, title and blurb.
- Recognising full stops, exclamation marks and question marks in a text.

We have particularly enjoyed:

Dinky Donky, I need a New Bum, Wanted Ralphy Rabbit, Book Burglar and Kind.
