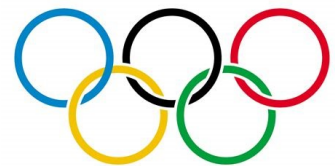
Our Term 4 Focus

In literacy this term we are continuing to work on our comprehension strategies and how to construct our answers in full sentences using words from the question to help us. We will be looking at Newspaper reports and creating our own all about Frothy Friday. We will use the information we learn about in our Science topic to create some explanation texts.

This term we will be starting off with our Numeracy and Maths topic all about Money and using money in real life situations this will tie in with our Enterprise/Technology topic of Frothy Friday. The children will be involved in running their own business, making and selling milkshakes to the rest of the school. This will cover areas such as giving change as well as beginning to understand how money is made, buying products and how businesses make profits. We will then focus on Fractions, Decimals and Percentages which will follow our previous learning in Dividing. Miss McClymont will be focusing on Information Handling and Time this term.

Our first topic of the term will be Frothy Friday, the children learn about good food hygiene, marketing through advertising their products and using money in real life. We will then join with the rest of P4 to P7 to learn all about Forces and Chemical Changes in a Science topic. In Health and Wellbeing the children will learn about The Olympics, particularly the different sporting events involved as well as some countries taking part.

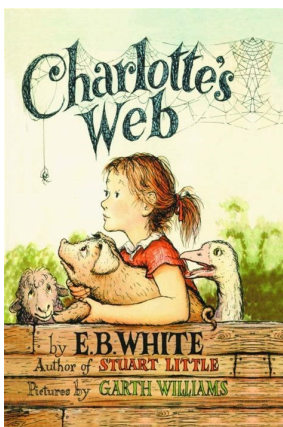
We will learn about some Islamic festivals and traditions this term as the pupils demonstrated lots of interest in this before the holidays.
