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#### Our Term 4 Focus

LITERACY- This term we will be developing the skills required to work successfully as part of a team. In preparation for our visit to Sky Up Academy Studios, P7 will be working in groups to create a storyboard for a film. They will be introduced to the Sky Up Academy Studios storytelling programme. P7 will learn about the theory of 'binary opposites' (Levi Strauss) and how it is often used in film and television narratives.

**NUMERACY**- To begin the term, we are focusing on Fractions, Decimals and Percentages. Learning how to find equivalent fractions, simplify fractions and find fractions of amount. We will use practical methods such as bar modelling to help support learning in this area. P7 will also be exploring Time with Miss McClymont and Measure with Mrs Blakeman.

#### TOPIC —Forces and Chemical Changes

This term so far, we have rounded off our topic on World War 2. We are now moving on Forces and Chemical Changes. We will investigate examples of everyday chemical reactions, such as burning and corrosion. We will collaborate with others to safely demonstrate simple chemical reactions, for example, effervescence. Primary 7 will also investigate magnetic, electrostatic and gravitational forces. Practical challenges will allow P7 to apply their understanding of buoyancy and forces.



#### READING FOCUS

This term we are reading Percy Jackson and the Lightening Thief. This is the story of twelve year old Percy Jackson and how he manages the most dangerous quest of his life. Along the way, he faces a host of mythological enemies determined to stop him.



Through the text we will explore a range of topics including Greek Mythology, Friendship and Additional Support Needs. Primary 7 will take part in a range of activities to enhance their learning in all of these areas.
