

Term 1 Learning Information for Primary 3



TOPIC



Our IDL Topic this term is focused on The Twits by Roald Dahl. We will be looking at character descriptions, feelings and reciprocal reading strategies, such as predicting and clarifying. During science activities, we will be exploring the results of a germ science experiment through looking into how germs grow and can spread. We will also be focusing on hot seating and conflict resolution between characters during Drama lessons.

LITERACY



In Literacy, we will continue to build on our knowledge surrounding description text types using descriptive bubbles (number, size, colour, shape, doing, texture, position). We will continue to learn new spelling patterns using the Jolly Phonics programme. During Grammar lessons we will be focusing on verbs, adverbs and the past and future tense.

NUMERACY



In Numeracy, we will be extending our knowledge of number through sequencing, ordering and place value. This will involve counting on/back, using symbols to compare numerals and finding missing numbers on a number line. In Maths, we will begin to look at the properties of 2D Shapes and 3D Objects.

PE DAY



Our PE hall slot is on Monday afternoons. Plain black (dark) trackies and a plain t-shirt under the usual school jumper will be expected on PE days. Children should wear their school jumper and only need to wear the change of clothes during the lesson time. Children can bring a plain jumper to wear during PE.
