



## Term 2 Learning Information for Primary 4/5



TOPIC	This term we are going to be focusing on the history of specific seasonal events, including Guy Fawkes night and Armistice Day. We will continue into December by learning about Christmas traditions and stories around the world. There will also be times to reflect upon current affairs throughout the term.
LITERACY	This term we are focusing on different styles of poetry in our writing reflecting the events and change of seasons that are happening. In reading we will continue to build upon our comprehension skills, practising our skimming and scanning to answer specific questions and reading for information to take notes.
NUMERACY	This term we will explore the link between addition and subtraction, building upon strategies previously learned and applying them to larger numbers and word problems. We will also be learning about Measure in length, weight and capacity.
PE DAY	PE days will continue to be on Friday and Wednesday, pupils can come dressed for PE on a Friday and bring something suitable on Wednesday to change into. We will be learning about Badminton and Social Dance on Fridays and Yoga on a Wednesday.
