TOPIC	This term we are going to be focusing on the history of specific seasonal events, including Guy Fawkes night and Armistice Day. We will continue into December by learning about Christmas traditions and stories around the world. There will also be times to reflect upon current affairs throughout the term.
LITER <i>AC</i> Y	We began the term with some poetry writing which involves using a range of literary techniques such as similes, metaphors, alliteration and onomatopoeia, other writing tasks will follow later this term.
