








Term 3 Learning Information for Primary 3



TOPIC 	Our IDL topic this term is Scotland. We will go on walks in the local area to take pictures, create maps/models and compare Stranraer to other places in Scotland. As well as reciting Scots poems, we will focus on Scots words and create a Scots dictionary. In Expressive Arts we will explore drama strategies, traditional Scottish music/instruments and Scottish artists.
LITERACY 	Our information reports in writing will focus on describing and comparing Scottish animals and Scottish landmarks, using all seven of our description bubbles. In Grammar, we are developing our knowledge about antonyms and synonyms. We will continue to learn new spelling patterns using the Jolly Phonics programme.
NUMERACY 	In Numeracy, we will continue to focus on subtraction strategies and the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction. Afterwards, we will begin to explore multiplication and division. In Maths, P3 will work on being able to tell the time using 12 hour clocks and identify the link with 24 hour notation.
PE DAY 	Our PE hall slot is on Monday afternoons. Plain black (dark) trackies and a plain t-shirt under the usual school jumper will be expected on PE days. Children should wear their school jumper and only need to wear the change of clothes during the lesson time. Children can bring a plain jumper to wear during PE. Please also ensure shoes are suitable for PE on this day.
