

# Term 3 Learning Information for Primary 3/4



### TOPIC



This term our topic will be Scotland. We will research facts about Scotland and explore some of the places around Scotland. As part of our topic, we will be learning more about Scottish Wildlife and Scottish Myths/Mythical Creatures as this was a keen collective interest suggested by the children. As a class we will be reciting Scottish poems, learning Scottish dances and listening to traditional Scottish music.

#### LITERACY



In Literacy, we continue to focus on more reciprocal reading strategies and comprehension skills in group and whole class situations. We will continue to learn new spelling patterns and grammar skills using the Jolly Phonics programme. Spelling words can be found in your child's homework jotter. In writing we will begin to focus on narrative writing for the remainder of the term.

## NUMERACY



In Numeracy we will extend our knowledge of number facts through addition and continue to focus on our mental maths skills through the use of SAMSON Maths. As the term progresses we will begin to focus on multiplication, and repeated addition. Children are encouraged to practise their times tables at home to help with this. For maths this term, Miss Teasdale will begin to focus on Time.
