







Term 3 Learning Information for Primary 4/5



TOPIC 	This term our IDL will be all about Scotland. We will be focussing on the geographical landscape as well as learning about life in the different areas as we travel around on a virtual tour. We will be learning lots of different songs and exploring the different dialects/languages spoken. We will also focus on Scottish Artists.
LITERACY 	Our class novel continues to be The Christmas Pig by JK Rowling that was started before the Christmas holidays and we will focus on stories, myths and legends as we travel around Scotland. In writing we will be using the features of information texts to create leaflets about our local area and we will learn about writing newspaper reports as we find out about the Loch Ness Monster and other mythical creatures.
NUMERACY 	In Numeracy we will complete our Subtraction topic and move onto Multiplication and Division. We will learn lots of different mental strategies as well as beginning to look at the written methods. We will learn about Position and Movement while exploring maps during our Topic time. We will also focus on Money this term.
OTHER INFORMATION 	We will resume our Outdoor Learning in February and will aim to spend time outdoors on a Friday afternoon whether it is learning in the playground or exploring the local area.
