TOPIC 	<p>This term we will be learning about Scotland, in particular the geography and landscape of the country as well as the economics of our own local area. As usual we will be learning Scot's poems and our first class book of the year will be The Eejits. We will also find out about some Scottish Artists and work on creating pictures and paintings inspired by them.</p>
LITERACY 	<p>Our main class novel is The Night Bus Hero by Onjali Q Rauf. This is a more modern book which the children will be able to relate to and from it we will be looking at making inferences. When it comes to writing we will focus on writing more and start working on functional pieces such as reports, instructions etc</p>
NUMERACY 	<p>Over the term we will continue working on written processes, especially multiplication and division. Learning times tables is on-going. We will also be tackling skills to do with telling time and counting money and relate these areas to real life situations. As well as this we will be beginning fractions and decimals, which will hopefully be made easier with the continuing times tables activities.</p>
