TOPIC



The whole school have a Scotland IDL focus this term. In P6 we will be learning about famous Scots, doing some research on the Scottish wars of Independence and of course, learning our Scots poems. Your child will have a poem home with them to learn and the judging will take place on the 11^{th} of February.

LITERACY



Our writing focus for the term is discursive writing where we will be looking at language used to convey a balanced argument. We will be debating different topics and listening to everyone's points of view to help us see things from different perspectives. We will follow on from this to work on persuasive writing, where we will be looking at how the media uses persuasive techniques to influence us in different ways.

NUMERACY



In Numeracy we have started the term with multiplication and division. We will follow on from this with working on fractions, decimals and percentages. This will include simplifying, using knowledge of equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages, finding a fraction, decimal and percentage of an amount and solving problems using the skills we have practised.
