<p>TOPIC</p> 	<p>To begin this term our IDL will be all about Scotland. Primary 7 have shown an interest on the history of Edinburgh and wider Scotland. We will explore famous Myths and Legends, delve into the dark history of Edinburgh and find out more about the Kings and Queens of Scotland.</p> <p>Moving on from our Scotland topic, we will learn about WW2, particularly the impact the war had on our country. We will explore evacuation, rationing, the Clydebank Blitz, propaganda and much, much more!</p>

We are enjoying the humour that is added by the Scots vocabulary.</p> <p>Through our literacy work, we will explore the work of Robert Burns. Focusing on his story telling and use of vocabulary. In writing, we will be creating our own poems using the language we are learning.</p>
<p>NUMERACY</p> 	<p>In Numeracy, we are revising and extending our skills in Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division. We are doing this through the context of money. In a few weeks, we will be moving on to Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.</p> <p>Miss Caitlin Farquhar will be in Primary 7 on a Monday morning until the end of the year. Her initial focus will be Measure (Length, Mass and Capacity). Primary 7 will enjoy a range of practical and outdoor learning opportunities.</p>
