

Term 4 Learning Information for Primary 1



TOPIC



Our IDL topic this term is Night and Day. We will explore why earth has day and night. Our activities will be based around the story 'The Owl who is Afraid of the Dark' and meet Plop, a baby barn owl with a big problem - he is afraid of the dark!

We will also learn about nocturnal animals, planets and stars.

LITERACY



We will continue to focus on blending (running sounds together to read a word) and revise diagraphs and the formation of letters. We will also continue to explore the importance of capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and writing on the line. We will continue to encourage children to write simple sentences and will discuss the importance of finger spaces and full stops. Capital letters are being introduced and children are learning to recognise them and match them to the lower case letter.

NUMERACY



In Numeracy, children will be focusing on adding and subtracting within 5 and 10. We will count, write and order numbers to 20 and complete number sentences. Miss Teasdale will be focussing on Measure for Maths on Friday with the children learning about length and capacity over the coming weeks.

OTHER INFORMATION



In technology, Miss Teasdale, will be introducing basic programming using the Beebots and discussing directions. In PE, Primary 1, will be developing their athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day.
