<b>TOPIC</b> 	<p>Our IDL topics this term will be Titanic and The Human Body. We will learn about the timeline of events leading up to the sinking of Titanic as well as some of the experiences different passengers may have had on board.</p> <p>When learning about The Human Body we will learn about different body systems including the respiratory system and the digestive system as well as the function of our bones and muscles.</p>
<b>LITERACY</b> 	<p>We will continue our CYPIC Writing this term and will be focusing on imaginative writing and report writing linked with our IDL topics.</p> <p>In Reading we will look at the features of non-fiction texts through our IDL topics and in our groups we will be thinking about inferences.</p> <p>We will continue to enjoy watching Newsround as part of our Talking and Listening.</p>
<b>NUMERACY</b> 	<p>In Numeracy this term we will be learning about Fractions. We will find the fraction of a shape and an amount, compare fractions and will learn about equivalent fractions.</p> <p>We will learn about Time in Mathematics. We will be looking at both analogue and digital time as well as thinking about duration. We will also be looking at different timetables and how we would use them to organise a trip.</p>
<b>OTHER INFORMATION</b> 	<p>Pupils have been very busy making and selling their milkshakes this term as part of a money topic before the holidays.
