Recently retired **Sally York** is a qualified teacher, Chartered Forester and with decades of experience as Land and Forestry Scotland's Education Policy Advisor, she steered and influenced national partners (government, Education Scotland, GTCS, third sector and others) to enable more educators to take their pupils outdoors for learning and play; in the school estate, locally or to places further away.

Education Consultant **David Cameron** has extensive experience in school management at all levels. He was Director of Children's Services for Stirling Council, Head of Education in East Lothian, and an Area Manager for Fife schools. He was President of the Association of Directors of Education Scotland and been involved with a range of national groups, notably on Curriculum for Excellence, Outdoor Education and Looked After Children. David chaired the Scottish Government's Outdoor Connections group which embedded outdoor learning in Scotland's education policy. He is a longstanding trustee of Learning through Landscapes and a smallholding farmer.
