Civic Visits

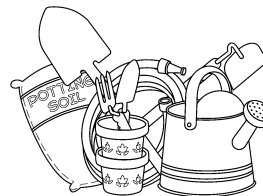
The visits to the Civic Centre will be continuing throughout the year. The focus has been on gardening but will include arts and crafts and other activities as we move into winter.
