



Dropping off and Picking

Children should be dropped off and picked up within the designated time for each session. This is necessary to allow staff time to set up and clear away and to allow activities to get underway. It also allows the staff who are manning the door to return to their other duties.

If you require to drop off or pick up out with these times please speak to Nyree, our Senior, to make arrangements.

Pick Up 11:40 - 11:50am

Afternoon Sessions

Drop Off 12:35-12:45pm

Pick Up 3:25 - 3:45pm

Key Workers

Your child has a Learning and Care Plan while at nursery. Your child's key worker will discuss their progress, targets and any changes with you. This can be done informally at drop off or pick up times. If you would like more time to speak to your key worker we can arrange an appointment. If you have any queries or concerns please speak to your key worker or Nyree, our senior ,at any time.



If your child is sick or has diarrhoea they should not return to the ECC for a minimum of 48 hours after the last bout.



This is the NHS recommendation and an East Ayrshire policy.

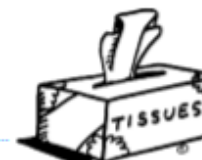
Please let us know if your child is going to be absent. You can contact us on :

Outdoor Play



The children will play outside on most days, whatever the weather. Please bring a jacket everyday and shoes they can play outside in the playground in—lightweight trainers or gym shoes are ideal for indoors.

It is helpful to have a pair of wellies to leave at nursery. They will need them for their outdoor days when they spend the session over in the green space and for other rainy days activities too.



Outdoor Day - Usually Wednesdays but we use the garden/ green space whenever we can.

Snack and Lunches

Snack is provided every day and the snack menu is displayed in the corridor along with the weekly lunch menus.



Snack is £2 donation weekly. This money enables us to buy a varied and healthy snack. Any extra money goes into our nursery fund which we have used previously to pay for buses for our trips and outdoor toys.

Out and About

Throughout the year our pre-school children will visit the school and we have some joint activities with the primary children.

All the children will be visiting the Civic Centre and the Community Garden on a regular basis.
