Outdoor Learning Day 3 - Wednesday 15th May 2019

What will pupils be doing? The pupils will work in their House groups, to encourage cross-stage working and to promote school community learning. This will mean that our senior pupils in P6 and P7 will have responsibilities for younger pupils, which helps with transition and playground behaviour too.

What should pupils wear? We intend to be outside for most of the morning (hopefully the weather will still be sunny!), so pupils should come to school on Wednesday 15th May wearing suitable clothing for the weather - warm jacket, trousers/trackies, wellies/boots. Basically clothes that can get dirty!!! 😊
