# Party In The Sky

Preparation

- blow up the balloon
- pour some water into the bowl

**Rain box**                    **It was raining in the rainforest.**  
*They shake the rain box.*

**Letters in envelopes**        **Raining letters!**  
*Drop a “shower” of letters over them, and/or get them to drop them themselves.*

**Letter/envelope**        **The big black bird, Uluru, read the letter. “Please come to a party in the sky.”**  
*Help them to remove the letter from the envelope and read it to them.*

**Party streamer**        **“Yeah! Party!”**  
*They wave the streamer.*

**Green balloon**        **‘I’m coming too!’ said Frog. ‘I’ll jump.’**  
*They bounce the balloon into the air.*

**Action**                    **“You can’t jump up to the sky!” laughed Uluru.**  
*Shake finger at them.*

**Guitar**                    **But Frog wanted to go to the party. He hid in Uluru’s guitar.**  
*They feel the “guitar” strings and pluck them.*  
**Uluru flew up to the sky with the guitar on his back.**  
*Raise the guitar with their hands still on it.*

**Music**                    **Frog was the star of the party. He danced and sang to Uluru’s guitar.**  
*Play music and get them dance to it.*

**Guitar**                    **On the way home, Frog didn’t feel well.**  
**“Let me out!” he shouts.**  
*Bang on the back of the “guitar” whilst shouting “Let me out!”*

**Green balloon**        **Uluru shook his guitar, and Frog fell down, down, down...**  
*Drop balloon from a height.*

**Board**                    **SPLAT!!! He broke into pieces!**  
*Get them to hit the board.*

*Please turn over*

**Tape dispenser**            **But Uluru stuck him back together again.**  
*Help them to stick some tape on the balloon.*

**Bowl of water**        **“You stay in the pond.” he said to Frog. “You don’t belong in the sky.”**  
*They feel the water.*

**“OK” said Frog, but he never forgot that he’d been to the party in the sky.**

## Items needed for this story

**Rain box** - Any container with a lid. Put a large handful of rice, lentils or similar inside.

**Letters** - 4 or 5 envelopes, each with a letter inside. Do not properly seal the envelopes. You can write on the letters and decorate them if you wish, but this is not essential.

**Party streamer** - Any sort of party streamer.

**Green balloon** - Have a few spares in case it bursts. You may wish to draw a face onto the balloon to make it look more like a frog. You will probably have to replace this each time.

**Guitar** - Mid-sized plastic tub with a few rubber bands stretch over it. Or you can use a real guitar if you have one.

**Board** – A chopping board or hard place mat would be ideal, but any sort of hard board would work.

**Tape dispenser** – Sellotape or similar.

**Bowl of water** – A small bowl would be fine.
