Have fun!! ☺ <i>Example:</i> My dog <u>wears</u> a blue and purple dress when he takes a bath.</p>	<p>3 Times Each Write your spelling words (neatly) three times each. <i>Example:</i> cried cried cried</p>	<p>Build a Word Choose half of your words and write each of your words one letter at a time and add one more each time. <i>Example:</i> h ha hap happ happy</p>
<p>Synonyms/Antonyms Choose half of your spelling words and find a synonym or antonym for each. <i>Example:</i> Different: Antonym=similar Discuss: synonym=talk</p>	<p>ABC Order Write all of your spelling words in ABC order. Or in reverse ABC order. <i>Example:</i> apple banana peach plum raspberry</p>	<p>UPPER and lower First, write your spelling words normal. Then rewrite each word with the vowels in lowercase and the consonants in uppercase. <i>Example:</i> lower LoWeR</p>
<p>Alliteration-Tongue Twisters Choose half of your spelling words and create a tongue twister. <i>Example:</i> Seals: Sally saw some seals by the sea.</p>	<p>Spelling is Valuable! Choose half the spelling words and write each spelling word and its value. Vowels are 2 points and consonants are 1 point. <i>Example:</i> Fourth = 8 points (1+2+2+1+1+1)</p>	<p>Puzzlemaker.com Choose half of your words and create a word search. Make sure to print out your word search.</p>
<p>Syllable Division Divide each of your spelling words into syllables. Use a dictionary for help if needed! <i>Example:</i> hap/py ex/ci/ted</p>	<p>Colorful Words Write each of your spelling words with each letter using a different color. <i>Example:</i> colorful</p>	<p>Part of Speech Choose half of the words and write the part of speech next to it. <i>Example:</i> (noun) president (adjective) beautiful</p>
