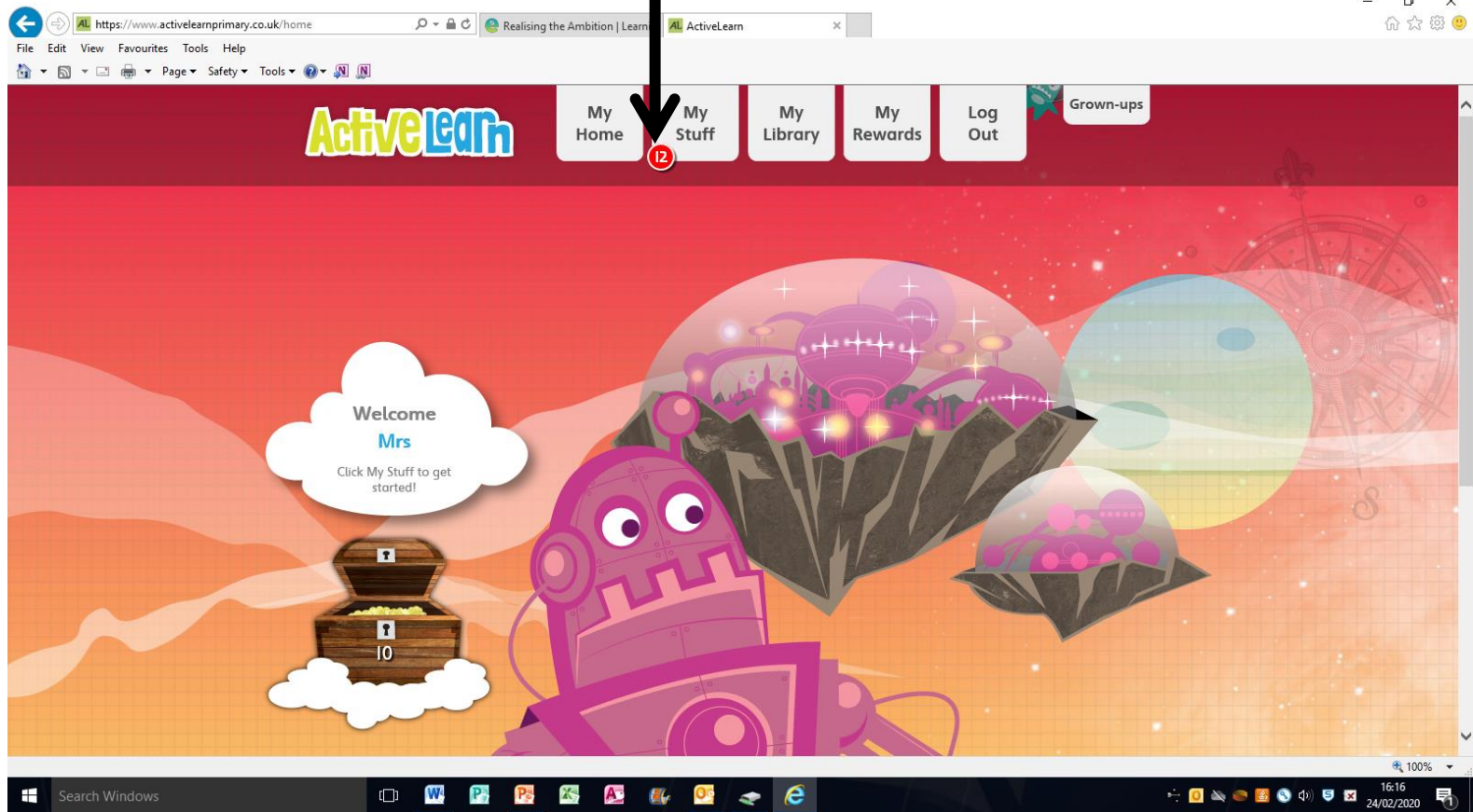

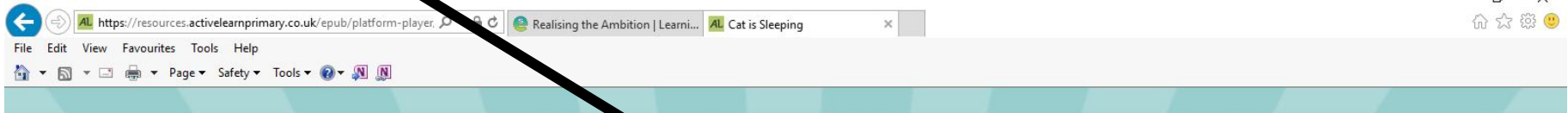
These arrows move back and forward through the book.

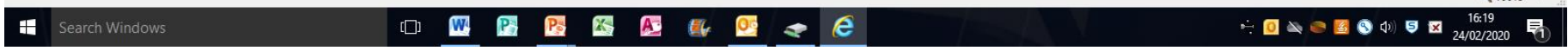
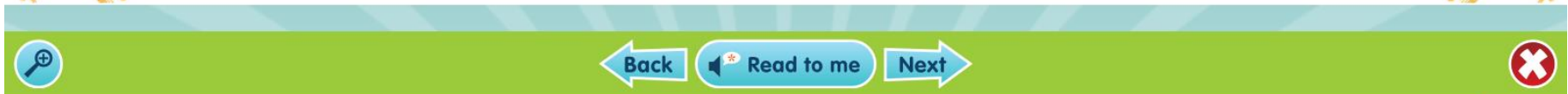


