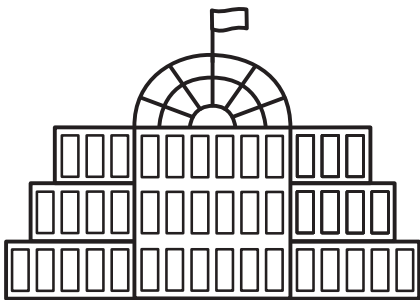

The Great Exhibition was opened at Crystal Palace by Prince Albert.



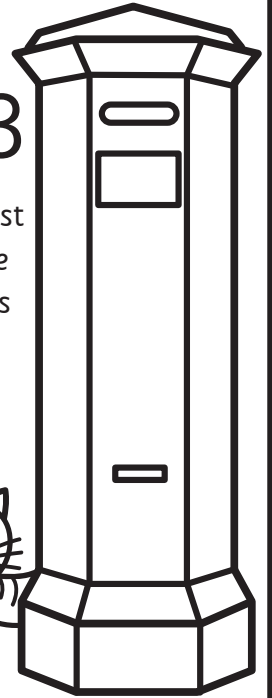
1851

The first free public library was opened in Winchester.



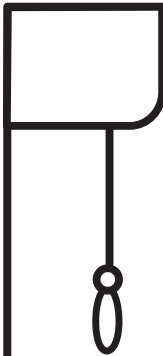
1853
