6. Head Teacher Updates:

The Scottish Attainment Challenge for schools is now being rolled out at local authority level. East Ayrshire is now a Scottish Attainment Challenge Authority and there will be funding associated with this. Peter has met with local primary HTs to discuss this and start working on a sustainable action plan.

Peter gave an update on staff changes, some staff are temporary and further interviews planned.

Results: National 5 5+ down to 26% which is disappointing for year group, this S4 group has had a high number of non-attenders.

1+ Highers achieved by 54%, similar to last year, 3+ Highers A-C increased from 28% to 33% and 5+ Highers A-C increased from 8% to 14% from last year (9 pupils achieved 5 A's)

New School: an update letter will go out to parents this week
