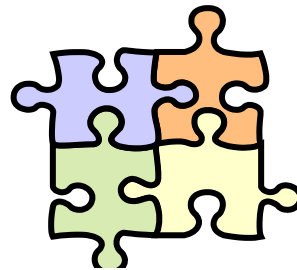
Writing -
