- * Viking Runes - writing names using ancient Viking letters.

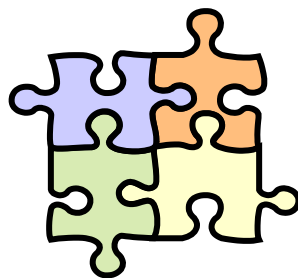

Numeracy

- **Octagons, Hexagons and Pentagons** - Place Value of numbers up to 1,000. Sequences and patterns - skip counting in 2's, 3's, 5's etc
 - **Diamonds** - Place Value of 3-digit numbers. Looking at patterns and sequencing numbers passed 100.
 - **Squares and Triangles** - Recap numbers to 100, counting in 1s, 2s 5s and 10s to 100 and vertical addition.
 - **Circles** - Tens and Units - partitioning numbers, understanding what each number represents passed 20.
