

CAR PARK **ARRANGEMENTS**

If you are dropping off vour child by car, please refrain from

using the Disabled Parking bays & Taxi Zones. These spaces are for blue badge holders only.

FIRST 2 DAYS AT SCHOOL

Your child's first week at school will be Wednesday 21st till Friday 23rd August 2023 from 9.30am until 2.45pm.

From Monday 26th August—Fri 30th August children will be at school from 9.00am until 2.45pm.

From Monday 2nd September they will attend full days from 9.00am until 3.00pm.

Playground will be supervised from 8.50am every morning.

School closes at 3pm.

Please ensure you child knows their end of day arrangements.

Appointments

If your child has an appointment please put this in writing to their teacher or email the school with the details. The email address is noted above.

You must collect/return your child from/to the main office. Calling the office on your arrival from outside the main entrance.

Emergency contact Nos.

It is vital that you keep your emergency contact details up to date. Therefore, please inform the school of any changes in phone numbers, addresses or emergency contacts details.

Absences

If your child is absent from school please contact the school by phone or e-mail before 9:15am every day of the absence explaining the reason for their non-attendance. We have an absence telephone line available where you can leave a message with your name, child's name, class and reason for absence.

The school office is open from 8.30am, when someone will be available for any other calls.




In order to prevent large volume of telephone calls, please ensure your child is aware of their home time arrangements, eg. who is collecting them at 3pm.

Our classroom assistants are on duty at the gates and can radio each other if you need to change the collection gate of your child when you arrive.

Our school uses the ParentPay cashless system. This is used for payment of trips & activities throughout the year. When your child starts school in August an activation letter will be sent home for you to activate your child's account.

Campus Security

Health and Safety of our children and staff is of paramount importance to us as a school. Following a recent safety visit to all schools in the council there have been a number of procedures we must tighten up on.

- All doors will be on lock down except in the event of a fire drill.
- Pupils are only allowed to enter via the pupil doors.
- All staff must wear their ID Badge & lanyard identifying themselves.
- Parents should make an appointment to see a teacher.
- Late children must enter via the main office as children are not allowed to open pupil doors
- Gates will be closed during the school day and will be supervised in the mornings and at the end of the day.
- After Monday 26th August no parents will be allowed to enter the playground without permission. Your child's teacher will consult you of where to drop off/pick up you child.

School gates will be unlocked and there will be adult supervision in the playground from 8:50am every day. Unfortunately if your child attends school before 8.50am they are left at your own risk.

Early Childhood Centres

Although we don't have our own we stress a lot of importance on visiting your child regularly at nursery. Please make sure you have told us what Early Childhood Centre they attend.
