

Constitution 2024

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1. Title

The organisation hereby constituted shall be known as Bellsbank Parent Council.

2. Objective

Name of group Bellsbank purpose shall be:

- a) To provide financial, practical and resources to support the children of Bellsbank to develop links between the parents, the wider community and the Primary School
- b) To work in partnership with the Bellsbank Primary School to create a welcoming spirit which is inclusive of the whole community
- c) To promote parental involvement in their child's education and learning
- d) To identify and represent the views on the education provided by Bellsbank Primary School and other matters affecting the education and welfare of the children.
- e) To engage in activities which support and advance the education of pupils attending the Bellsbank Primary School
- f) To engage and support learning opportunities and training for parents and carers of the Bellsbank Community

3. Membership

- a) Membership shall be open to all parents/guardians/carers of children attending Bellsbank Primary school and to any other persons over the age of 16 years who have a vested interest in the aim of the group;
- b) All members identified above will have the right to vote in the election of Office Bearers and committee members for the Parent Council and on any other issues requiring a vote at the Annual General Meeting.
- c) Any person wishing to withdraw from the group shall inform in writing the office bearers of their decision. On receipt of such a decision the membership will cease immediately.
- d) Membership shall be available to anyone without regard to race, age, sex, sexual orientation, class, disability, gender reassignment, marriage and civil partnership, pregnancy and maternity, religious or beliefs.
