What happened in April?

April was a quick month for us due to the Easter break. We hope you all enjoyed your time off and are ready for the last term of the academic session; it's going to be a busy one.

Thank you once again to everyone who came along to our Easter bonnet parade. We got a great turnout and fantastic weather! It was lovely to visit the residents at Gracelands; this is something we want to continue to do more frequently as the children and residents get so much from this.

We were fund-raising as part of the Easter bonnet parade. Thank you to everyone who collected a sponsor sheet. We raised £981.00 for the ECC. This will go towards our summer parties and Graduation gifts for our preschool children. Thank you again for your generosity.

What's coming up in May?

We have lots of opportunities for you to be involved in the ECC this month, and we really hope you can come along to some of our planned events.

Tempest Photography will be in the ECC on Monday 12th May for any individual, sibling and family photos. These will take place in our Family Room. As before, we ask anyone looking for family photos with any siblings who don't attend the ECC, as well as any of our children who don't attend on a Monday, to come along in the morning if you would like to get photographs taken.

On Thursday 15th May, we will be taking our preschool children's Graduation photo. We will do this as early on in the morning to save any lunch spills or creative/outdoor play mess. We are aware some school transitions may be taking place on this day; we will make sure your child's photo is done for you either before they go or when they come in, depending on transition times.

WB 19th May is Parent/Carer progress meeting week. Your child's keyworker will have a list of appointment times on set days, and will catch up with you to schedule time to go over your child's Personal Plan and, if they are moving on to primary education after the summer break, their progress report, which will be shared with their primary school.

WB 19th May is also Walk to School Week. We will be linking in with Hillhead Primary School for the theme this year and will share more information shortly. We will also be looking at

ways to further support the good work we are doing towards our ECO award, and Rights Respecting School Award.

In WB 26th May, our Outdoor Stay and Play sessions will take place. Our children in the Jungle and Ocean Rooms want to create a fairy garden in their outdoor spaces and we're looking for your help to create this magical space for them. We will be looking for donations so please keep an eye on your child's Learning Journal, and on our noticeboards for both a donation list and our sign-up sheets. These will take place on Monday 26th, Tuesday 27th and Thursday 28th. More info in our key date section on times.

On Wednesday 28th May, we will be hosting a family sports day. This will be weather depending as we will be outdoors, using Hillhead Primary School's playing field. This will take place from 9:30am to around 10:30am. We will have various potted sports stations and there will be some fun races at the end. We hope as many of you can attend to join in!

Parent/Carer improvement plan newsletter

Important information reminder

- Please contact our office on 01563 533177 if your child is going to be absent from the ECC – we will call you if your child is absent from the ECC without prior notice, and please let the office staff know of any days off, holidays etc.
- You can also notify us of absence via the school app – please see the office for information on how to download and set this up
- If your child has an episode of sickness and/or diarrhoea, there is a 48-hour exclusion period from the last episode – please do not send your child in if they have been sick and/or had diarrhoea in the last 48 hours to ensure we avoid spreading any illness – if our staff become ill due to this, they too are required to be off and this can impact our service delivery. If you are in any doubt as to whether your child can come into the ECC with certain infections/illnesses, please call beforehand

- We have 3 fully trained First Aiders in our ECC – Laura, Gillian O and John; we also have a number of Emergency First Aiders. Laura is also a Mental Health First Aider and ASIST trained
- If you child requires medication during their session, we will require a prescription label before anything can be administered to your child, and we require to complete a consent form with you therefore it may be useful to call ahead to let us know or set time aside when dropping your child off with medication
- Please arrive on time for your child's session and please collect on time at the end of your child's session – we know sometimes things come up and you can be running late so please contact our office if you are delayed however the doors open at 8:40am and close at 9am / open at 2:35pm and close at 3pm to allow staff to clean and prepare for the next day
- Please do not come for your child before their collection time unless this is for an appointment or pre-agreed – we are very busy playing and learning right up until the end of our sessions
- We would appreciate if you would avoid putting any food or drink items in your child's bag – some of our friends in the ECC have allergies which can make them very ill
- If your child prefers to drink water or milk from a specific style cup, please let us know so we can support them with this whilst also offering them the opportunity to try using our cups too
- Please provide your child with a change of clothes (a few sets if they are learning to use the toilet or are recently using the toilet independently) and include a few pairs of socks and underwear
- Please label your child's belongings with their name – we're a big ECC and things can easily get mixed up so this will help items to be returned to their owner
- Please provide wipes, nappies or pull-ups, sun cream and a sunhat, and a puddle suit and wellies for your child if you can – we do have our own which the children can use
- We always appreciate donations of wipes, tissues and nappies, and we rely on donations of clothing items, particularly socks, pants and trousers/leggings – thank you

- Our uniform is not compulsory but can be purchased from a number of school-wear shops in Ayrshire – we do recommend your child wears clothing you don't mind getting messy.
