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29 AIMS OF EDUCATION <u>Transitions to Primary 1.</u>

All children in the ECC have been allocated a Buddy from Primary 5/6.



Children who are 3 years old will have a Primary 5 Buddy.

Children who are 4 or 5 years old and are moving into Primary 1 after the Summer will have their Buddies from last year return.

We have a Buddy Programme planned from now until the Summer Holidays where the

Primary 5/6 children will visit the ECC regularly to further develop their relationships with the younger children.

These visits will usually take place during the afternoon in the ECC.

Children who are not attending Fenwick PS will have Buddies allocated to allow them to build positive relationships and links with others in our ECC community. We will work closely with other Primary Schools to ensure your child has a positive transition experience.

We will provide a further details on our extended Transition Programme when we have finalised dates with Fenwick PS colleagues.
