After the ECC children have performed Parents/ Carers can exit via the fire escape at the back of the hall, if they wish.

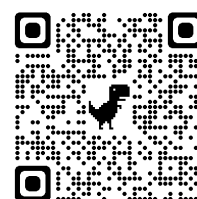
