### Outdoor Clothing

As the weather becomes nicer the children are spending longer periods of time outdoors.

Sometimes they will wear their jackets rather than their full suits when playing outdoors.

Each group has trolley which is marked with their group logo and is the playroom that they register in.

Your child's jacket can be placed on these trollies at the beginning of each day and collected from the trolley each afternoon.

We are moving the Star trolley from behind Playroom 1 door to allow more space and easier access to both the Star and Sunshine trollies.

This will help ease transition to outdoor play and allow your child to access the garden independently without having to ask to access the ECC corridor.

#### Sun Safety

After the Easter holiday it would be extremely helpful if children could bring in a bottle of SPF 30+ sun cream for use in the ECC. Please clearly mark the bottle with your child's name and date of birth.

For siblings, the same bottle of cream can be used, clearly marked with both children's names and dates of birth.

On sunny days please apply sun cream to your child before coming to the ECC. The basket with sun creams will always be present in the ECC corridor for you to access the bottle you provide. Staff will reapply sun cream during the session.


### Did you know that sun cream expires?

Please check expiry dates of sun cream before use. The letter 'm' and the number on the bottle shows the number of months the sunscreen will last after opening. Sun cream that has been open for longer than this time can reduce the protection on your child's skin.
