Blue, Green, Red, Yellow p.m. groups (Star Room) Main entrance


Blue & Green 12.20 p.m. – 3.30 p.m.

Change of Clothing

We would be grateful if children could bring in outdoor footwear and clothing to the ECC. This should be placed in a plastic carrier bag with their name clearly marked on it. A change of clothes and indoor shoes can be kept at the ECC. We will keep these items in the drawstring bags which we have for each child. Your child's name should be marked on all their belongings.

Please note that the Sun Room children should be dressed for outdoor play at the start of the session as they begin their session outdoors.

The overall aim is to reduce the amount of bags/personal belongings that children bring in to the Centre.

Snack Payments

Although children are receiving a snack each day, we are currently not collecting snack payments due to the COVID recommendations regarding cash handling. Moving forward, we will keep you updated as regards any changes to this.

Suncream

We would like to request that you ensure that you apply suncream to your child before he/she attends the ECC.

We would be very grateful if you could hand in kitchen roll and tissues each term. These should be placed in a plastic bag prior to handing over to staff at your entrance. Thanks in advance.
