Below is an overview of the work which will be covered by the class this term.

Literacy

- Active literacy Phonics and Spelling- ss, ll, ff, ow (owl), ou and oi
- Active literacy Common words 3 each week and consolidation of previous words (Reading and Spelling these)- I'm, well, tell, will, call, small, going, old, how, now, down, your, our, out, about, walk, want.
- SAC DUG Grammar (Common nouns, Alphabetical order, a/ an, plurals, pronouns, initial blends and verbs)
- Reading –Bug Club reading. Develop “Find it” Prove it” Talk about it” comprehension strategies with shared texts.
- Writing –continue descriptive writing and introduce letter writing following EA programme.

Numeracy

- Reinforce place value (tens and units)
- Addition and subtraction to/ from 20
- Addition (tens and units. Tens and units with carrying)
- Subtraction (tens and units. Tens and units with decomposition)
- Symmetry
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's (up and down)
- Count in 3's
- Count in 10's starting at a different number e.g. 2,12,22 etc.
