Below is an overview of the work which will be covered by the class this term.

Literacy

- Revision of sounds from P1
- Active literacy Phonics (consolidation weeks are built in after a block of 3 phonemes)
 - Revise sh, th, ch, ng, wh, ph, ee, oo, ck, ai, oy, oa.
 - Introduce: ay, ea (leaf), y ('ee' for example funny)
- Spelling of phonics sounds above and common words.
- SAC DUG Grammar: capital letter, sentence construction, proper nouns, common nouns.
- Reading –Bug Club reading. Develop “Find it” Prove it” Talk about it” comprehension strategies with shared texts.
- Writing – Narrative writing following EA SAC COW programme inc black pen drawings and sentence/ sentences related.

Numeracy

- Revise number sequence and number names to 20 (including numbers before, after and between).
- Develop number sense and place value to 100
- Revise addition to 20
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's (up and down)

- Mental Health – Emotions
- PE – Ball skills (inc. football, basketball).
- NCCT- Mrs Rands PE -Team games & ball skills.
