Things to Remember:

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL/CENTRE – If your child is absent from school it is important that you make contact with us as soon as possible. To help with this we have an automated phone system that will allow you to record/leave a verbal message about your child's absence. This can be done day or night at a time that suits you. **Please remember, that on your child's return to school, a written note in relation to the absence should also be provided.**

LATE ARRIVALS – If you are late dropping your child off in the morning then they must report directly to the **school office** so that their attendance can be recorded prior to going up to class / Centre.

EARLY COLLECTION FROM SCHOOL/CENTRE – If you require to collect your child throughout the school day (perhaps for a dental appointment or they become ill etc) they will require to be signed out in the school office in the event that they are returned to school they will require to be signed back in. Children attending the Early Childhood Centre will sign in/out at the Early Childhood Centre.

PUPIL SNACKS – Please ensure that if you are sending your child to school with a snack/packed lunch that some of our pupils have serious nut allergies. With this in mind we would ask that you avoid sending in any snacks or packed lunches, where it is practicable, that may contain traces of nuts. Your support in this matter is appreciated.
