Fantastic Jacob!



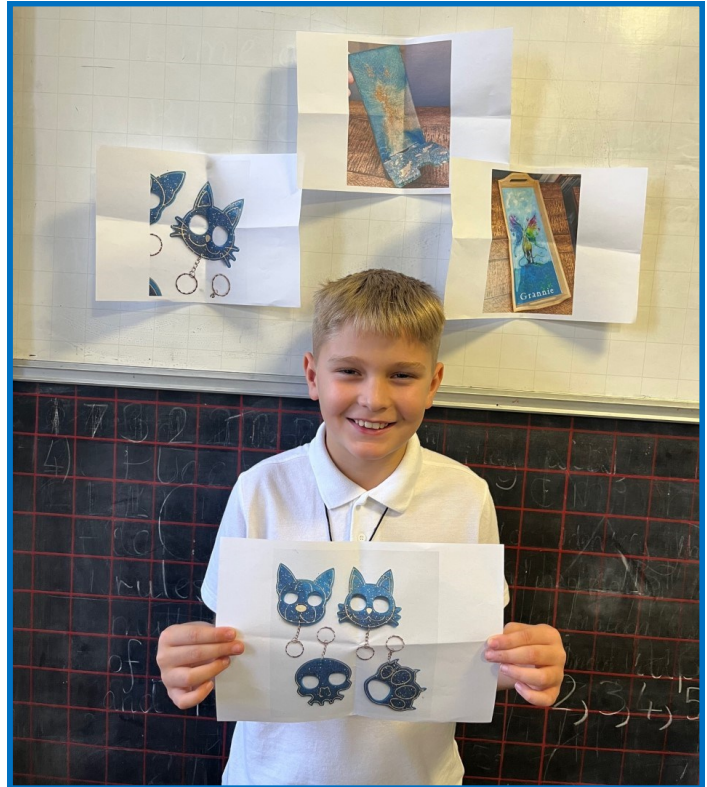
Caleb R12 P4

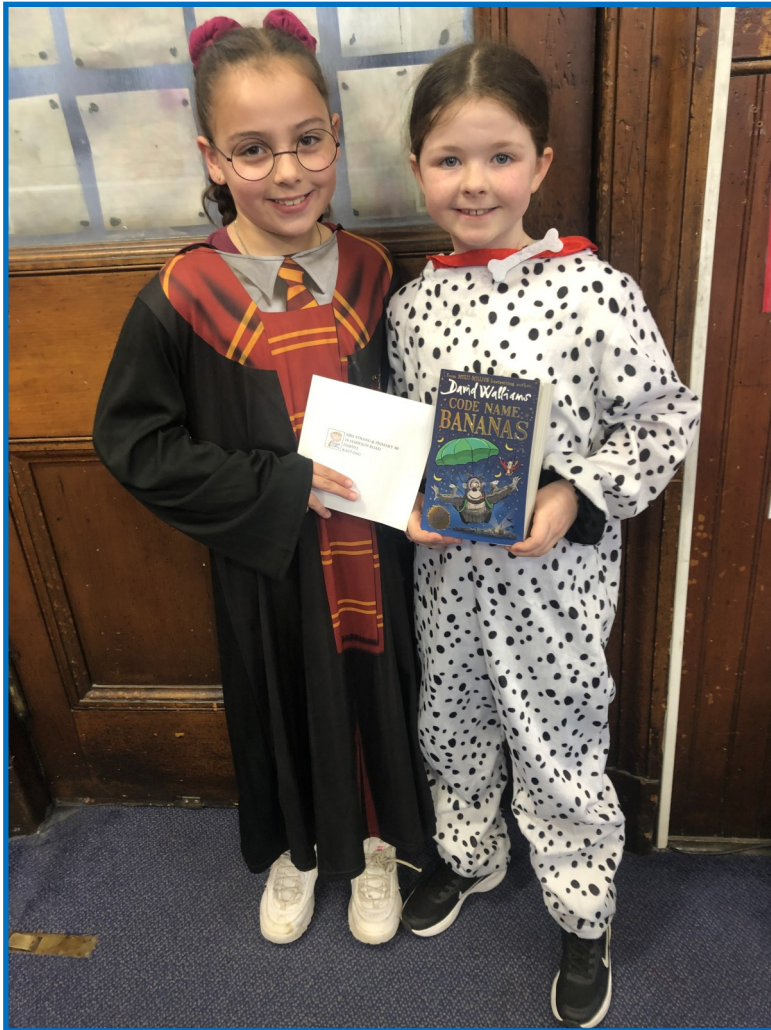

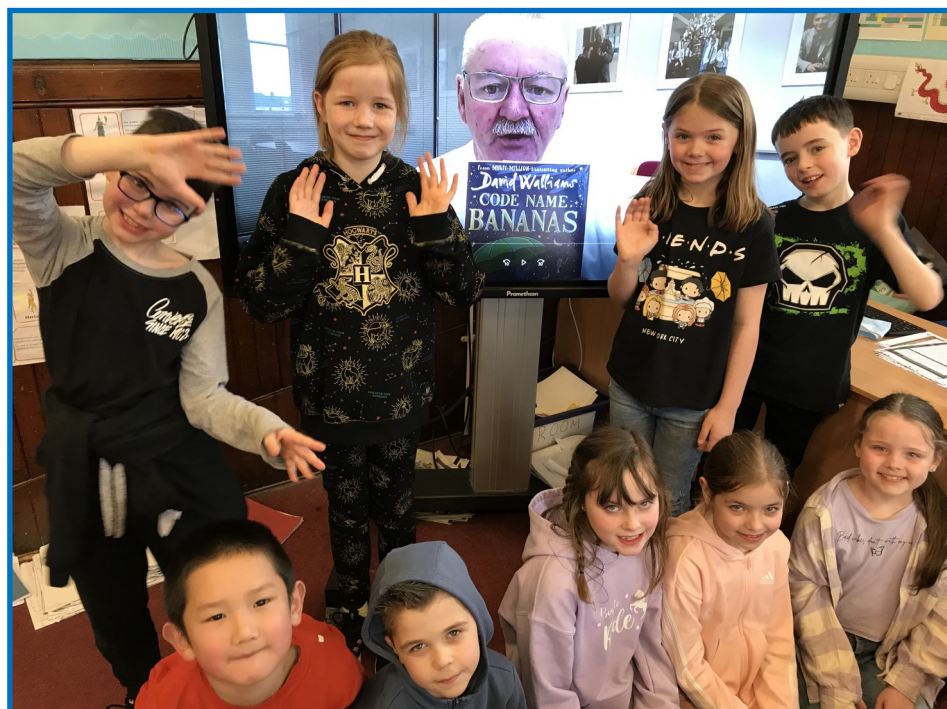
