



## August to December Curriculum Overview

### Language and Literacy across Learning



- Novel / Reading – Class novel tbc and personal daily reading time individual and group.
- Reading Strategies – Comprehension questions, metalinguistics and visualisation.
- Grammar – Capital letters, nouns, synonyms and adjectives.
- Active Literacy Spelling Programme – ae, a, b, d, ee, e – differentiated words.
- Writing – slow writing, descriptive and poetry.
- Handwriting – revision of letter formation and introducing cursive.
- Talking & Listening – Book club discussion of novels, likes and dislikes and recommendations.

### Mathematics and Numeracy across Learning



- Number Talks mental maths strategies – Daily mental maths questions.
- Whole numbers and place value – Read, write, order, count whole numbers up to 100,000, add/subtract up to 4 digits carrying and begin to show my understanding of addition and subtraction of decimals to at least one place.
- Multiples, factors and products (4 operations) – Multiply at least 2 and 3 digit numbers within 2 to 10 times table and 100 using written method and mental strategies.
- 2D and 3D shapes and symmetry – Describing triangles by their sides, revise naming of 3D shapes including cube, cuboid, cylinder, sphere, cone, square-based pyramid, triangular based pyramid (tetrahedron), triangular prism and Octahedron, and introduction of vertex/vertices.
- Surveys and graphs in information handling.

- PE – Fitness and team games and dance.
- Children's Rights – Class Charter and Right of the Month.
- Emotion Works – Introduce all cogs with relate activities.
- Cooperative and Growth Mind-set activities
