Language and Literacy across Learning



- Novel / Reading – African comprehension, Shared reading: Butterfly Lion (Michael Murpurgo)
- Reading Strategies – Reading Strategies – Prior Knowledge, Metacognition, Visualization, Inference, Main Ideas, Summarizing
- Grammar – Capitals, nouns, adjectives, commas, synonyms, antonyms
- Active Literacy Spelling Programme – ow, oi, k, ks : daily activities

Mathematics and Numeracy across Learning



- Number Talks mental maths strategies – Mentally add and subtract 3 digit numbers, discussing strategies used
- Place value – Rounding up to two decimal places
- Addition, subtraction and links between – Add and subtract up to 4 digit numbers using written methods etc.
- Multiplication, division and links between – Multiply 2 digit numbers by multiples of ten without a calculator (36×60) ($36 \times 10 + 36 \times 6$ – using factors), multiply 4 digit numbers within 2 – 10 times table and 100 using formal written method and divide 3 – 4 digit numbers within 2 – 10 times table and 100, 1000 including remainders.
- Shape – Discuss 2D/3D shapes with reference to tessellation, symmetry, faces, edges, verticals, diagonals, sides and angles.
- Symmetry – Discuss 2D/3D shapes with reference to tessellation, symmetry, faces, edges, verticals, diagonals, sides and angles, identify parts of a circle (radius, diameter, circumference).
