Create a bird feeder out of a plastic bottle and two spoons

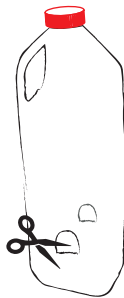
You can make your own bird feed with things that birds like to eat, like sunflower seeds and raisins.

What you need:

- A plastic bottle
- 2 wooden spoons
- A pen
- Scissors
- String, wire or ribbon
- Bird feed, shop-bought or made at home



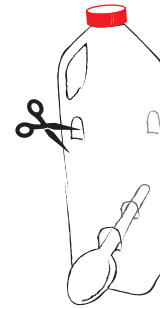
STEP 1

Cut a hole near the bottom of the bottle. Always ask a grown up to help when you're using scissors.



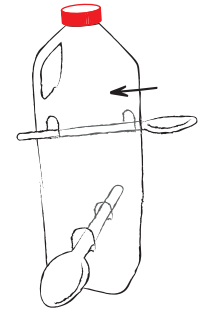
STEP 2

Poke a spoon through the hole. Use a pen to mark where it touches the other side and cut a hole where the mark is.



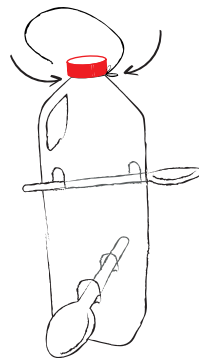
STEP 3

Repeat steps 1 and 2 higher up the bottle.



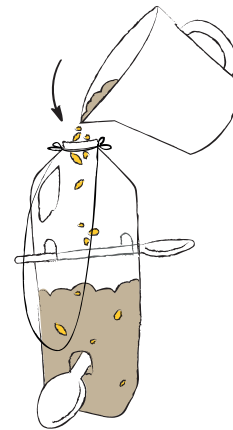
STEP 4

Push a spoon through the two holes near the bottom, then push the other spoon through the two holes nearer the top.



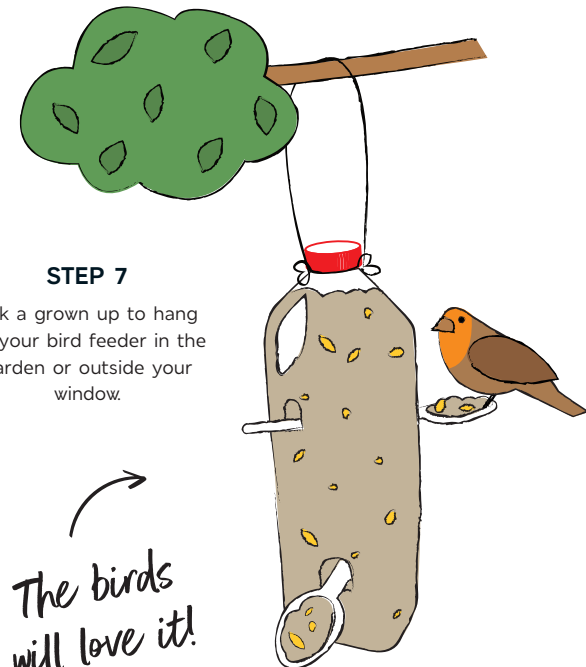
STEP 5

Tie the string around the neck of the bottle. Make sure the knots are tied tightly!



STEP 6

Fill your bottle up with bird feed and screw the lid back on.



STEP 7

Ask a grown up to hang up your bird feeder in the garden or outside your window.

The birds will love it!
