P7 TRANSITION- FINAL TERM ARRANGEMENTS

As I write to you today, I can't quite believe we are already in the final term of this school year! This term will be a memorable one for your child as they spend their final weeks at Primary School, and of course look forward to their future in The Robert Burns Academy.

P7 Information Evening

S1 Classes and Personal Information

We have begun the process of organising the S1 classes in preparation for the June induction days. I have asked your child's school to issue a form that we require, indicating any medical conditions or siblings that they may have who are already in our school. I would appreciate it if you could return this to your child's school as soon as possible. We will share the details of the new classes with P7 teachers on the w/b 6th June.

Induction Days- 21st and 22nd June

We look forward to welcoming our new S1 to the school for a two day 'induction' on Tuesday 21st and Wednesday 22nd June. Your child's primary school will share the transport arrangements for the days with you nearer the time. The purpose of these two days is to allow our new S1 to meet their new schoolmates and teachers, while experiencing some of the learning activities from the S1 curriculum. I will write to you in advance, to outline the finer details of the programme for both days. P7 classes will also be shown a video made by some of senior students, featuring interviews with our many of our staff members and giving them some tips for success before they arrive in June.
