SOC 0-04a</p>	<p><u>Outline Key Learning of Plan</u> We will provide the children with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pictures/books and a range of natural resources to create their own castles or palace i.e. outlast blocks, wood, bricks etc. • Opportunities to explore and discuss how the Queen travels and recreate these using recyclable materials i.e. car, carriage, train etc. • Opportunities to explore and discuss the Queen's loves of horses and dogs • Resources and media to create a mural of the Queen in the style of Andy Warhol. <p><u>Outline Children's Key Learning Skills</u> The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify at least two different types of evidence which can provide information about the past, i.e. books, pictures, promethean board. • Uses knowledge of the past to demonstrate a difference between their life today and life in the past. i.e. lifestyle, homes. • Uses a range of materials when creating a pictures/models/concepts and identify which material is suitable or not for specific function/task. • Respond to the work of an artists, and recognises colour, line, shape and at least one more of the visual elements: form, tone, pattern, texture.
