Literacy



Spelling - We will continue to work on our Active Literacy spelling and phonemes and tricky words.

Reading - We will continue our Find It, Prove It, Talk About It strategies with our fiction books. We will also do some non-fiction texts and reading for information with our topic.

Grammar - We will be working on our sentence structures, plurals and past tense.

Writing - We will do a lot of our writing around our topic. We will write a newspaper report and some persuasive and explanation pieces.

Talking and Listening - We will learn and perform our Scots poem. We will take notes about our topic on things we watch to show our listening skills.

Numeracy & Maths



We will be learning about 2D and 3D shape. We will also be learning about all aspects of measure.

We will continue to work on addition and subtraction in a variety of contexts. We will also look at patterns and their relationships to numbers.

Number talks will also continue to be used to help us use a variety of mental maths strategies to support our numeracy.

Health & Wellbeing



As part of our Health lessons we will continue with our Massage in Schools programme.

We will also be looking at Food and Health and we might even try a few cooking lessons as part of our Scotland fortnight.

In P.E. we will be working on our fitness and learn why it is important to keep fit and what happens to our bodies when we exercise.

Social Studies & Science



This term will have a focus on Social Studies; we will have our Scottish Fortnight where we will look at Famous Scots.

Our Social Studies topic will be Knights and Castles. We will look at different castles and the role of a knight. We will mainly focus on Scottish castles. We will look around Scotland and the different castles. We will compare our lives to a knight's life.

Technologies



We will create our own shields and work together to decide which materials would be best for a shield and also which materials we can use for a replica.

We will take part in experiments and discuss force, including push and pull for a drawbridge and portcullis.

We will design a knight's shield and a Castle Coat of Arms.

Create a piece of artwork inspired by the Bayeux Tapestry. Create my own 'Castle and Sun' piece of art like the one that Paul Klee made.
