LITERACY

Reading

As a class the children will read Kensuke's Kingdom to begin with. The children will explore Active Literacy reading strategies such as:

- prediction,
- metalinguistics,
- visualisation,
- inference,
- main idea
- summary.

These strategies will be used to help demonstrate a deeper understanding of the content being read in class.

Writing

This term we will be visiting a range of different genres through taught writing lessons and our IDL topics, including: discursive writing and persuasive writing. The children will continue to work on their Tools for Writing.

The main focus will be on our tools for writing (punctuation, paragraphing, spelling, connectives, and sentence openers) with children learning how to use these features to enhance their writing further.

Talking and listening

The children will complete a variety of listening activities that relate to their novel and the class topic. The children will also take part in listening games such as 'listen and repeat' tasks.

NUMERACY & MATHS

Number Talks

We will continue to work on 'Number Talks' our programme. Number Talks enhances mental agility and we will be focussing specifically on addition and subtraction. Children are encouraged to articulate their thinking, explaining why they have chosen a particular strategy.

Numeracy

Some areas we will be covering this term are:

- Estimating and rounding
- Decimals
- Read, write, order and count whole numbers to 1 million and beyond.
- Addition and subtraction of four digit numbers and more. (with and without carrying)

To begin the term the children will be learning about Thailand, they will also explore Buddhism. After that, children will learn about Romans. This year, P6 will continue working towards their John Muir Award.
